What will the Online Course be like?

20 hours per week in a Live Classroom Environment with teachers, you and your classmates. These scheduled classes will allow you to meet your classmates, undertake activities and presentations in small groups (synchronous learning).

5 hours per week of anytime Guided Individual Learning if you are studying during the day; My Study, Exam Practice or Assignments are structured to support your live classroom activities and are **fully flexible** to balance with your lifestyle (asynchronous learning).

One-to-one Consultation with **your teacher**, which you can book weekly to review your learning plans and study goals. These **private sessions** with your teacher allow you to focus on what you need and be guided to reach your full potential.

What Online Courses can I study?

We offer a wide range of courses, including:

- General English
- Cambridge Preparation
- IELTS Preparation
- Academic English

How many days and hours will I study per week?

Daytime online courses run for a total of 5 hours per day and evening courses for a total of 4 hours per day - Monday to Friday every week.

Do I have to attend every class?

You should commit to studying at least 80% of online classes so that your learning progress will be fastest and best supported by our education professionals.

How many students will I study with?

Online courses are limited to 18 students per class which may vary.

Will I get the Online Course timetable in advance?

Yes. All class start and finish times are confirmed when you enrol. Each scheduled class will operate to Australian time zones. With a range of flexible timetables, select the one that best suits your preferences and commitments.

Are Online Courses recorded?

Live lessons are not generally recorded to protect your privacy. If you miss classes you are given help to catch up on any work missed.

What learning materials will I study with?

All learning materials are provided, including an e-book containing core course content together with all other supplementary materials.

Will I receive a certificate at the end of my course?

Yes. You will receive an official paper certificate for all courses, which may be mailed or emailed to your home address following completion of your study.

I am going to study at university later. Do Online Courses still give me direct entry?

Yes. We are working closely with our university, TAFE and college partners to confirm that all direct entry agreements continue to apply for transition to further study.

Please talk with a Director of Studies or your agent about the pathway and course you want to follow so that we can confirm your individual requirements.

What devices do I need to study Online Courses?

It is possible to join online courses using only a smart phone to access Zoom and Moodle.

For a richer and more comfortable learning experience, we recommend joining online courses with a tablet such as an iPad (good) or from a PC or notebook (best).

The faster your internet connection, the better.

All software, apps and learning platforms are provided to you during orientation and your first lessons.

Will I have IT support?

Yes. Our staff and IT support are available to help you with technological issues during courses.

Can I meet my classmates and other students outside class for social interaction and fun activities?

Yes. Our Online Social Activities Program includes fun learning opportunities such as Conversation Club, together with enjoyable social activities like Quiz Competitions, online yoga, happy hour meet-ups and other games and activities so that you can meet up with classmates, make new friends, and enjoy the company of people from around the world.
