How it works

Within each of the two levels you can elect to study 5 weeks in Module A or B or 10 weeks in A + B. Each module targets areas which will support you as you embark on your studies at college or university.

ACADEMIC ENGLISH 2 For Diploma Students	Practise and complete two in-class writing assessments – Process Description and Compare and Contrast essay . These different writing tasks are what you can expect in any field of study at university or technical college.	Practise and complete two in-class writing assessments – Cause and Effect and Graph Description essay . These different writing tasks are what you can expect in any field of study at university or technical college.
	Prepare and present a Seminar Presentation . You will research a contemporary issue in your field of interest and prepare a 10 - 12-minute presentation with visuals, as well as some discussion points for your audience to participate in a 5-minute seminar discussion.	Practise and complete a 1000-word Research Report using real academic research methods.
ACADEMIC ENGLISH 3 For Degree Students	Practise and complete a Literature Survey . You will learn how to read academic texts in detail and then summarize the information in 2000 words.	Prepare and present a 20-minute seminar presentation . You will research a contemporary issue in your field of interest and prepare a 15-minute presentation with visuals, as well as some discussion points for your audience to participate in a 5-minute seminar discussion.
	Participate in a Collaborative Speaking Task with your classmates. This task really looks at your ability to interact in a collaborative group discussion, the way you will need to at university and later in the work place.	Practise and complete a Research Essay on the topic of sustainability. You will need to research the topic and then write an academic essay in 1600 words.

8 Things you will master during the 5-week program

- 1 You will improve your study skills, reading, writing, listening and speaking as well as practising grammar and learning new vocabulary. You will need this at college or university to communicate effectively.
- 2 1-2-1 Conferencing sessions with your teacher to ensure you have the skills required to complete each assessment and on time.
- 3 You will undertake types of assessments you may experience in your future studies.
- 4 You will learn how to integrate the use of technology into learning and production of course work – valuable for your future assignments.
- 5 How to avoid plagiarism.
- 6 Consolidate your language, research and presentation skills. This is key for success in your future studies.
- 7 You will learn and practise time management skills such as the ability to manage multiple academic assignments simultaneously. You will need to master this for your future studies at college or university.
- 8 You will be effective at managing the amount of preparatory reading required to give you the best opportunity to succeed from day 1 of your college or university course.
