Follow your pathway

Curtin English, in partnership with Navitas English, offers courses that improve your English writing, reading, speaking and listening skills, for entry to Curtin University or Curtin College.

Courses include elementary to intermediate-level General English, which is taught by Navitas English at its Perth location. They also include intermediate-level Gateway English and the university-ready English Language Bridging course, which are taught by Curtin English at the Curtin University campus.

Curtin English accepts many English tests, some of the accepted tests are:

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS) (General or Academic)
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
- · Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE-A).

The English course suitable for you will depend on your English language test result. If you have no English test result, Curtin English may be able to organise one for you.

Get a Curtin English scholarship

A Curtin English scholarship provides up to A\$6,780 toward your university tuition.

To qualify for a scholarship, you must:

- complete a Gateway English or English Language Bridging course
- transition to a Curtin University undergraduate or postgraduate program.


Meet your English requirement from home

You can apply for English Language Bridging and study online if you haven't yet decided which university is right for you.

This will give you the language proficiency, academic literacy and study skills you need to succeed at university and also prepare you for the TOEFL test, which is required by numerous universities around the world.

You will need to have an English score equivalent to IELTS 5.5 or higher to start.

• A "standalone" course means studying an English course only.
